# TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

## CODE OF CONDUCT

1. This Tournament will be conducted in accordance with Tennis Australia's Member Protection By-law, these rules & regulations & the Tennis Australia Events Disciplinary Policy (each as amended from time to time).
2. I acknowledge that I agree to comply with the ITF Rules of Play, the Tennis Australia Events Disciplinary Policy (including its reference to spectator behaviour & interference), the Tennis Australia Member Protection By-Law & the Tennis Australia Anti-Doping Policy.
3. Inappropriate spectator behaviour could result in denial of entry at future Kurunjang Park Tennis Club events, & will be dealt with in accordance with these policies. This includes, but is not limited to tennis venues, hotels & transport vehicles.
4. I acknowledge that all Tennis Australia policies can be readily viewed at [www.tennis.com.au](http://www.tennis.com.au) & that it is my responsibility to view these & seek clarification, if required, from Tennis Australia.

## CONSENT

1. I consent to being involved in any publicity during the Kurunjang Park Tennis Club tournament, including interviews, photographs or video footage. Please inform the tournament organisers if you do not wish to be involved in publicity
2. I consent to Kurunjang Park Tennis Club to use details provided on the entry form to communicate information about this and future tournaments and general club information, via post or email.

## REGISTRATION

1. All entrants are to be current registered playing members of Tennis Victoria and provide their Registered Player Number.
2. Juniors will be under the age of 18 as of the 1<sup>st</sup> October 2009

## RULES OF PLAY

1. The committee shall have complete control and may make any decision it deems necessary to ensure the continuity of the tournament.
2. Matches will be played on the courts at Kurunjang Park Tennis Club or any other venue available to the Tournament Committee, provided conditions & circumstances permit.
3. The use of ripple or bar soled shoes or heels, or spikes or bare feet is prohibited.
4. Regulation tennis attire must be worn.
5. Players shall be graded once all entries for the event have been received, and the length of draw for each graded section shall be determined.
6. Presentations to be held on the Monday (Labour Day) after the final match of the day are played.

## Draws

1. Saturday: Men's singles
2. Saturday: Women's singles
3. Saturday: Junior singles
4. Sunday: Men's doubles
5. Sunday: Women's doubles
6. Sunday: Junior doubles - any combination of boys and girls can be submitted.
7. Monday: Mixed Seniors
8. Monday: Any unfinished matches

## COUNTBACKS

1. The winner of each event shall be determined by the most games for. In the event of a tie a countback will be completed in order of; a) games against, if still tied b) the result between the tied entrants.

## TIME

1. Play starts at 9.30am each day.
2. Play will continue until the event is completed or until such time as the Tournament Committee deems the light or conditions to be unsuitable for play.

## LENGTH OF MATCHES

1. Singles – 6 game set with tie break at 5 all
2. Doubles – 8 game set with tie break at 7 all
3. Mixed - 8 game set with tie break at 7 all
4. The tournament Committee has the authority to vary the length of matches.

## CANCELLATION

The committee reserves the right to refuse any player(s) entry &/or cancel any event if the number of entrants is deemed unsatisfactory and all money to be refunded.

## TOURNAMENT CHARGES

1. All players - \$8 per player per day.

## PAYMENT

1. Payment to be made on the day of play. Payment can be made by Cash or Cheque.
